Applicant submits herewith amended claims under PCT Article 19. This communication is in response to the *International Search Report of the International Searching Authority* mailed by the European Patent Office on 18 May 2017 in the above referenced international application.

As required by Article 19, and Rule 46.1, Applicant's submission is timely, being no later than two (2) months of the mailing date of the International Search Report.

In compliance with Rules 46.2 and 46.3, the instant amendments are being filed directly with the International Bureau, in the English language.

Per PCT Rule 46.4, Applicant provides a statement under Article 19(1), herein.

As required by PCT Rule 46.5(a), attached hereto is a complete set of claims in replacement of the claims as originally filed, presented as "Replacement Sheets".

Per PCT Rule 46.5(b)(i) – (ii), Applicant states that the difference between the claims as filed and those as amended is as follows:

- Audio cues recited in original claims 6 – 9, and 12, are introduced into independent claims 1, 16, and 21, and various syntactical amendments to claim 1 are made to adjust for the revised content. Original claims 6 – 9 and 12 are – correspondingly – cancelled without prejudice.

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- A limitation (“time-streaming sequence”) in original claim 11 is introduced into independent claims 1, 16, and 21; original claim 11 is – correspondingly – cancelled without prejudice.
- Ranges recited in original claims 13 and 14 are amended to preserve proper dependency from amended claim 1.
- An adjectival description in original claim 19 is deleted because it lacks antecedent basis.
- The claims (and various dependencies) are renumbered to take account of cancellations.

STATEMENT UNDER ARTICLE 19(1)

The amendment herein is to insert limitations from claims 6 – 9, 11 and 12 into claim 1, wherein the scope of the amended claims is fully supported by the original claims, specification, and drawings of the application as filed. As such the amendments have no impact on the description and drawings and do not go beyond the disclosure of the international application as filed.

If re-publication of the international application is warranted in light of the enclosed amendment, Applicant hereby requests it.
