## 2. COMMUNICATION:

The International Bureau acknowledges receipt of your request to obtain the priority document US 62/589,300 from the DAS digital library on 20 December 2017. However the DAS digital library system indicates that the requested priority document is not registered in the system.

This is a two stage process:

First, please send a written request to the depositing Office to make use of DAS to register the priority document. Please note that certain Offices require specific forms to be filled in for this purpose (for the USPTO either form PTO/SB/01 or PTO/SB/39, for KIPO Form 19). Please see the DAS Participating Office page at [http://www.wipo.int/das/en/participating\\_offices.html](http://www.wipo.int/das/en/participating_offices.html) for further details regarding each Office. Once the depositing Office has taken the necessary steps to register the document in the system, you will receive a DAS access code relating to that application.

The second step is to provide/confirm the DAS access code to the International Bureau. You may send the access code either in the form of a letter, preferably uploaded online via ePCT public services at <https://pct.wipo.int/ePCT>, or else by directly entering the access code using the online Action 'Obtain priority document from DAS' in ePCT private services.
