## 2. COMMUNICATION:

The International Bureau acknowledges receipt of your request to obtain the priority document US, 62/525,021 26 June 2017 from the DAS digital library on 19 June 2018. However the DAS digital library system indicates that the requested priority document is not registered in the system.

Once the depositing Office has taken the necessary steps to register the document in the system, you will receive a DAS access code relating to that application.

The second step is to provide the DAS access code to the International Bureau. You may send the access code either in the form of a letter, preferably uploaded online via ePCT public services at <https://pct.wipo.int/ePCT>, or else by directly entering the access code using the online Action 'Obtain priority document from DAS' in ePCT private services.
