This communication is in reply to applicant's paper filed in the Patent and Trademark Office on
25 FEB 2019

Obvious mistakes may be corrected before the ISA/US in accordance with PCT Rule 91.1 (c), which provides that "the competent authority shall authorize the rectification under this Rule of a mistake if, and only if, it is obvious to the competent authority that, as at the applicable date under paragraph (f), something else was intended than what appears in the document concerned and that nothing else could have been intended than the proposed rectification."

In the present case, the proposed rectification does not meet the 2-part test:

1. It is not apparent to the ISA/US that a mistake has occurred in the drawing sheets 5/7-7/7 filed on 26 SEP 2018
2. It is not obvious to the ISA/US that nothing else could have been intended than what is presented as the proposed rectification:
 - 6/8: text omitted
 - 5/8-8/8: graph lines added
 - 7/8, 8/8: figures modified

Therefore, the ISA/US has decided to REFUSE the proposed rectification.

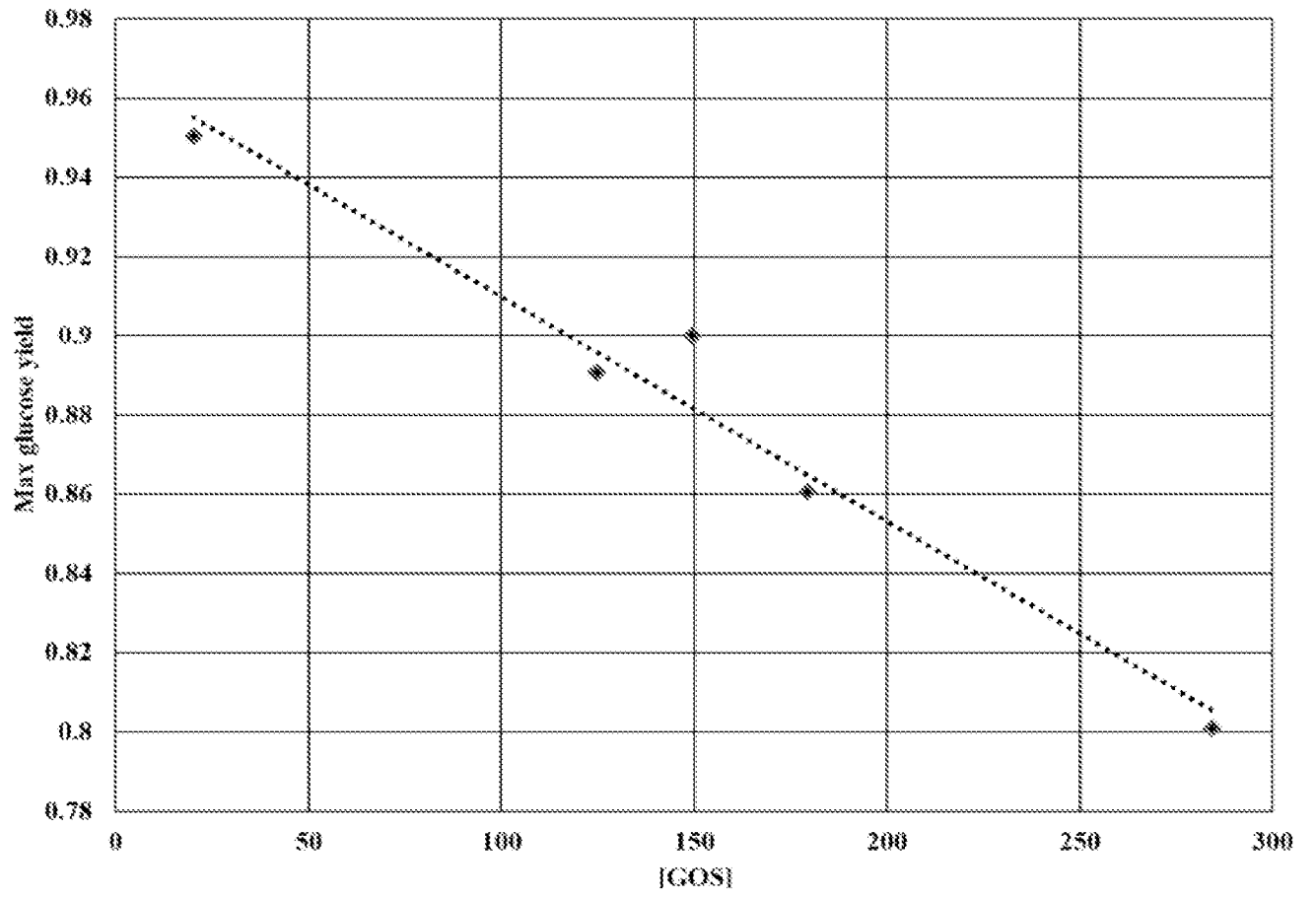

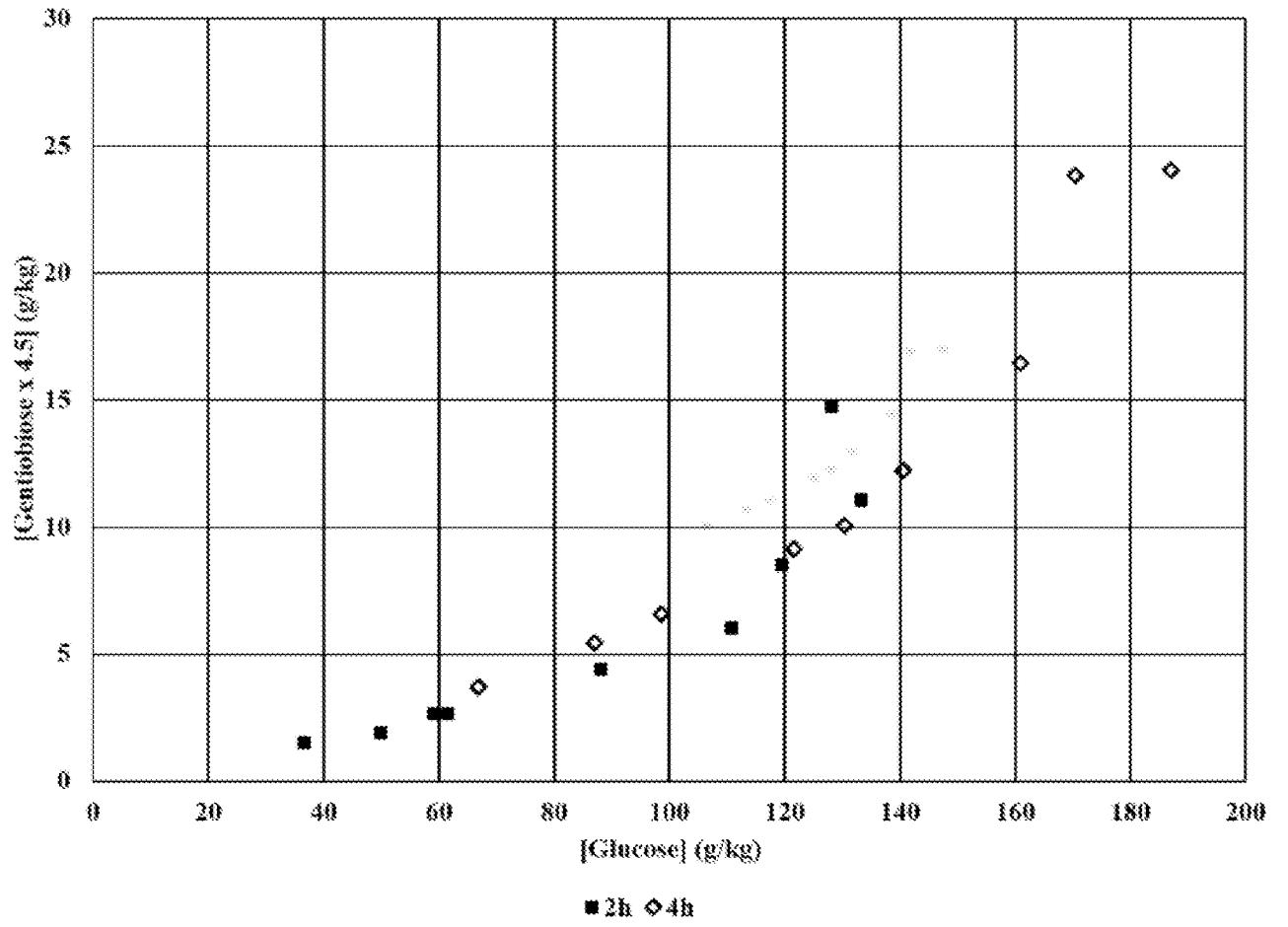

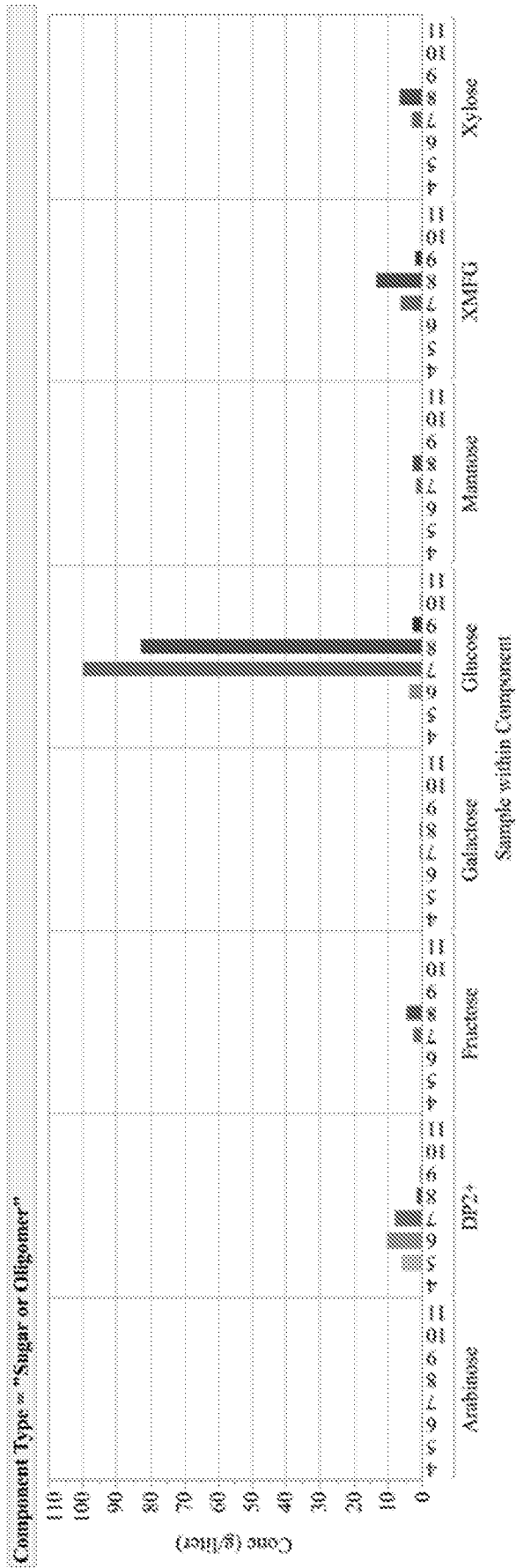

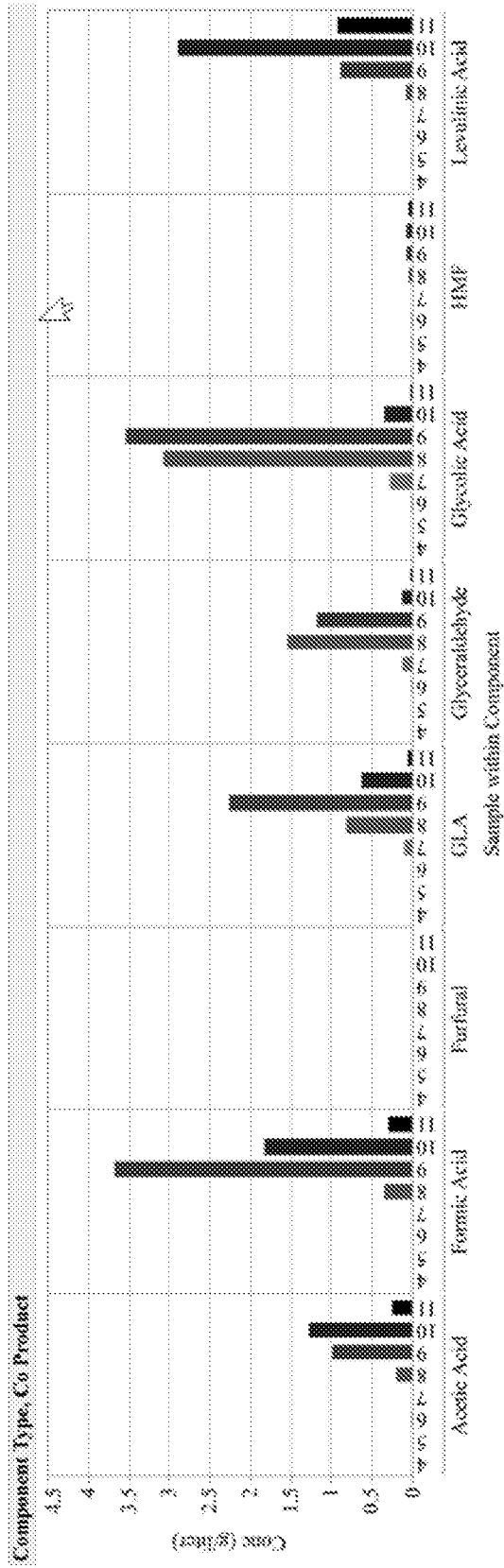
