## 2. COMMUNICATION:

The publication of the above-identified international application will take place shortly.

The applicant may contact the office of first filing in order to obtain the priority document through "DAS" Digital library and the IB may retrieve it upon the request from the applicant.

This is a two stage process:

First, request the depositing Office to register the earlier application in DAS. The exact means of doing this will depend on the requirements of that particular Office. See the DAS home page at <http://www.wipo.int/das/en/> and the PCT Applicant's Guide, Annex B <http://www.wipo.int/pct/en/appguide/index.jsp> of the DAS depositing Office for further indications of the procedure to be followed. You will then receive a DAS access code relating to that application, unless it has already been supplied to the applicant as part of a filing receipt, as is the practice of some depositing Offices.

The second step is to provide the DAS access code to the International Bureau. You may provide the access code by typing it directly into the ePCT online Action 'Obtain priority document from DAS' (sign-in with strong authentication required) at <https://pct.wipo.int/ePCT>, or in the form of a letter, preferably uploaded via ePCT.
